BREVARD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

SUBJECT:	Permission to Bid, Award and Execute the Agreement for the Transportation and Final Disposal of Mulch and Wood Waste from the Sarno Yard Waste Program, the Mockingbird Mulching Facility and the Central Disposal Facility and Authorize the Solid Waste Management Director to Execute Any Renewals to the Agreement

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Requested Action:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners grant permission to bid, award bid, authorize the Board's Chairman to execute the agreement with the awarded contractor and authorize the Solid Waste Management Director to execute any renewals to the agreement at the same terms and conditions for the transportation and final disposal of wood waste from the County's solid waste disposal facilities. Currently the price is \$8.25 per ton. If the price per ton is exceeded then the item will return to the Board for permission to execute the contract.

Summary Explanation & Background:

Solid Waste Management Department desires having its processed wood, vegetative and land clearing waste recycled to enable the County to receive recycling credits from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. In February 2011, the Board entered into an agreement with Wheelabrator Ridge Energy, Inc. for the transportation and disposal of approximately 30,000 tons of wood waste processed at the County's landfills and yard trash mulching facilities for an initial term of three (3) years. In March 2014 the Board approved the renewal of the existing agreement for an additional three (3) year term. The existing agreement with Wheelabrator Ridge Energy, Inc. is due to expire on March 13, 2017. This service provides an outlet for the disposal of excess mulch and other wood waste that is in excess of the Department's needs for alternative cover, not desired by the County's residents, or would otherwise be disposed in the County's landfills.

As the expiration date of the agreement with Wheelabrator Ridge Energy approaches, staff feels it could possibly be more cost effective at this time to resolicit bids for this service requirement. The terms of the bid would be for an initial three (3) year period with two one (1) year renewal options.

Solicitation of bids for this service would secure firm pricing and also gain additional competition that may result in lower pricing and an overall future cost savings to the County. The approximate dollar value for the previous year's agreement (March 2015 – February 2016) was Sarno Yard Waste, \$106,500; and Mockingbird Mulching Facility, \$122,300.
