Brevard County Code of Ordinances specify that on or before September 15 of each year, an annual budget shall be adopted for the Stormwater Utility Operations and CIP.

Fire Rescue Operations Assessment

\$97,581,221

Brevard County Code of Ordinances specify that on or before September 15 of each year, an annual budget shall be adopted for Fire Rescue Operations.

Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District

\$4,909,572

#### RESOLUTION NO. 2025-<u>095</u>

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT A FINAL OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE MELBOURNE-TILLMAN WATER CONTROL DISTRICT PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 165 AND 200, FLORIDA STATUTES, AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO ADOPT THE FINAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapters 86, 165 and 200, Florida Statutes, as amended, require that the Board of County Commissioners of Brevard County, Florida, adopt a resolution establishing an operating budget for the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District for the ensuing fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Brevard County, Florida, advertised its intent to adopt an annual budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- 1. This Resolution is hereby adopted under the provisions of Chapters 86, 165 and 200, Florida Statutes, as amended.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners, Brevard County, Florida, as taxing authority for the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District, does hereby adopt a final operating budget, as presented and amended at the public hearing held on August 14, 2025, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025, and ending September 30, 2026, in the amount of \$4,909,572.

- 3. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the Property Appraiser and the Tax Collector of Brevard County, Florida, and the Department of Revenue of the State of Florida.
  - 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners adopt the Stormwater Utility FY 2025-2026 budget for operations, maintenance, and capital improvements construction.
