

Actions: Pre-Event

- **Thursday:**
 - County Facilities closed.
 - Solid Waste opened to the public until 11:00 am.
- **Friday** – Facilities closed.





Actions: Post Event

- Saturday:
 - Assess facility damages.
 - Erosion damage to both landfill.
 - Damage to yard waste area in both Sarno and Cocoa.
 - Repaired damages to yard waste areas.
 - Opened to the public at 11:00am.
 - Repaired sufficient to open landfills to the public at 1:00 pm.



Actions: Post Event

- Saturday:
 - Started county debris assessment with three teams.
 - Debris contractors participated in the assessment.
 - Estimated debris is 300,000 cubic yards.
 - Over 90% is vegetative in nature.
 - Remaining is construction and demolition such as fencing.



Actions: Post Event

- **Sunday:**
 - Solid Waste facilities were open to the public.
 - Coordination and planning started for the collection process.
 - Preparation of Temporary Debris sites started.



Actions: Post Event


- Monday:
 - Coordinating continued with contractors.

 - Initial Temporary sites permits were activated.






General Information


- During the three hurricanes of 2004 we received over 500,000 cubic yards. For this event we received 300,00 cubic yards.
