**Requested Action:**  
 Request time at the November 15, 2016 County Commission meeting to present the 2016 Launch the Vote Student Art Contest 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Winners with a certificate and prizes from Chick-fil-A.

**Summary Explanation & Background:**  
 The second Annual Launch the Vote Student Art Contest for Brevard County 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders began on September 26<sup>th</sup>. The students were asked to design a patriotic and nonpartisan image in conjunction with the Launch the Vote theme to encourage voter participation in elections. Students are permitted to submit one entry by the October 11<sup>th</sup> deadline.

In an effort to showcase Brevard's talented students and increase awareness about the importance of voting, the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winning art entries will be displayed at all of the Brevard Chick-fil-A locations during the month of October. This contest will provide our future voters with an opportunity to participate in the election process and increase voter awareness.

Supervisor Lori Scott, Representatives from Brevard's Chick-fil-A locations (including the famous Chick-fil-A Cow), and the student winners will participate in the awards presentation. Each of the winners will receive a certificate and a prize package from Chick-fil-A.


