


PLAQUE COMMEMORATING RESOLUTION NO. 26-001



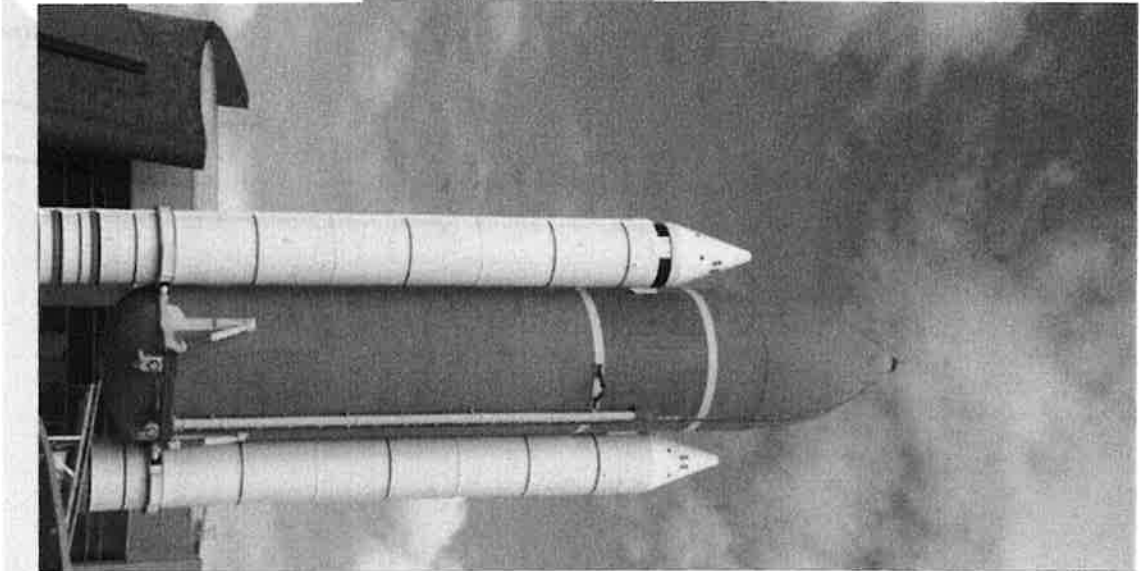
