
The Indian River Lagoon FY 14-15 State Funded

- o \$23.4 Million total in Brevard County
- o \$11,325,000 to Brevard County
 - \$10 Million for County muck dredging (1 million to FL Tech for muck research)
 - \$800,000 - Source Reduction & Legacy Load Remediation of Muck in the Indian River Lagoon
 - \$410,000 - Indian River Lagoon Oyster Restoration Project
 - \$115,000 - US 1 Dredging Project



The Indian River Lagoon FY14-15 State Funded

- o \$12,085,000 to SJRWMD and Cities
 - \$10 million for EGRET Muck Dredge Project – to SJRWMD
 - \$800,000 Titusville Water Quality Improvements
 - \$775,000 Rockledge Septic Tanks Elimination
 - \$500,000 Palm Bay Bayfront Stormwater Improvements



The Indian River Lagoon FY15-16 State Funded

- **\$23.6 Million total in Brevard County**
- **\$11,500,000 to Brevard County**
 - **\$10 Million for County muck dredging (including \$1.5 million to FL Tech for muck research)**
 - **\$1.5 Million for central sewer upgrades to prevent discharges to the Lagoon**



The Indian River Lagoon FY15-16 State Funded

- **\$12,049,000 for SJRWMD and Cities**
 - **\$10 Million to SJRWMD for Muck Dredging of the Eau Gallie River**
 - **\$589,000 Cape Canaveral City Park Exfiltration Project**
 - **\$400,000 Cocoa Beach Minuteman Causeway Stormwater Treatment**
 - **\$250,000 Palm Bay Basin 1 Stormwater Treatment Project**
 - **\$810,000 Melbourne Horse Creek Dredging Project**



The Indian River Lagoon FY16-17 State Funded

- **\$26.9 Million total in Brevard County**
 - **\$20 Million for Brevard County Muck Dredging Project**
 - **\$1,500,000 FL Tech Research on the Environmental Benefits of Muck Dredging**
 - **\$1M Groundwater Remediation with Marine Resources Council (MRC)**
 - **\$122,350 Johnson Jr. High School Stormwater Pond Denitrification & Phosphorus Reduction**



The Indian River Lagoon FY16-17 State Funded

- **272,500 Merritt Island Inflow & Infiltration**
- **\$71,200 Pines Industrial Stormwater Pond Denitrification & Phosphorous Reduction**
- **\$437,000 Scottsmoor Denitrification System**
- **\$300,000 South Beaches Inflow & Infiltration**
- **\$700,000 Treatment of Fresh Water Discharges to the Indian River Lagoon**



The Indian River Lagoon FY16-17 State Funded

- **\$1,240,000 Merritt Island High School Sykes Creek Drainage Project**
- **\$500,000 to Brevard Zoo for Restoring Natural Filtration Systems -Partnership with Brevard County and FL Tech**
- **\$105,000 to Titusville - Eliminating Nutrients from Knox McRae Watershed**
