SUBJECT:	Authorization to Apply for State of Florida Public Library Construction Grant for Construction of the new Mims Public Library
DEPT/OFFICE:	LIBRARY SERVICES

Requested Action:
 Library Services is requesting that the Board of County Commissioners (1) grant permission to the Library Services Department to apply for grant funding from the State of Florida to help fund the approved Mims/Scottsmoor replacement library project; and (2) authorize the Chairman to execute any and all associated documents associated with the grant that require his signature.

Summary Explanation & Background:

The Mims/Scottsmoor Public Library, located on property leased from the School Board, is currently in a portable building that is rapidly deteriorating. The portable structure has already exceeded its 20-year design life by eight years, and needs replacing. Accordingly, the Board of County Commissioners, in regular session on December 15, 2015, Item II.B.4., approved the new Lease Agreement with Brevard County School Board for the Mims/Scottsmoor Public Library replacement building; and authorized the Chairman to execute the Lease. This has been accomplished, and the lease allows Brevard County Library Services to build a new library building at that same location, and grants us the use of that site—exclusively for a public library—for the next 75 years.

The Department of the State of Florida, Division of Library and Information Services, provides state funds to governments to construct public libraries. Funds are awarded on a dollar-for-dollar match of the grant amount to selected governments after evaluation of applications. The maximum grant is \$500,000 and the minimum grant is \$10,000. Funds are reimbursed to local government entities based on stages of project completion.

By this action the Board of County Commissioners authorizes the Brevard County Library Services Department to submit the grant application, and the Library Services Director to sign the application and provide required certifications.

As required by the State of Florida, we affirm that:

1. The required dollar-for-dollar match of the grant request is budgeted and will be available and unencumbered at the time of grant award.
2. Funding for the entire project is sufficient and available, ensuring the project will result in a completed library building.
3. Sufficient funds are budgeted to operate the facility once the new building is completed.
4. The building will be used exclusively as a public library. If changes to the usage of the building are proposed within 20 years of completion of the construction project, the changes will be submitted to the Division of Library and Information Services for approval.

FISCAL IMPACT: Library Services has identified funds for this project in Business Area 1070, Cost Center 256650, GL Account 5650000. The Brevard County Facilities Department has estimated design costs at \$210,000, construction costs and contingency fees at \$1,857,271.25 totaling \$2,067,271.25. There is no fiscal impact to the General Fund.



SUBJECT:	Revised Lease Agreement between Brevard County School Board and Brevard County for the Mims/Scottsmoor Public Library replacement building
DEPT/OFFICE:	Community Services Group/Library Services Department

Requested Action:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners approve a new Lease agreement between Brevard County School Board and Brevard County for the Mims/Scottsmoor Public Library replacement building, and authorize the Chairman to execute the Lease.

Summary Explanation & Background:

In 1993 local resident June Horner initiated the effort to establish a public library in the Mims/Scottsmoor area. The nearest library was in Titusville, twenty-five miles south of the county line, and Ms. Horner's efforts were soon taken up by other local citizens, forming a support group—"Friends of the Library," collecting signatures, and meeting with County Commissioners and Library Board members. In response to this groundswell of support from the community, the Board of County Commissioners established the Mims/Scottsmoor Library Board in 1997.

At the time, the County had a vacant modular building available in Titusville, but there was not enough money in the budget to purchase land on which to place the building. Instead, an agreement was made with the School Board to relocate the building on the grounds of the Pinewood Elementary School in Mims. A Joint Use agreement was signed on January 13, 1998, providing a 10-year lease for the library building for \$1 per year, with two 5-year extensions possible. The County would pay to move the 14,200 square-foot modular building to the site, and would maintain it. Per the agreement, the building is shared between the County and the School Board, with 5,100 sq. feet allocated for school use and 9,100 sq. feet allocated for library use.

The Mims/Scottsmoor Library opened on January 9, 1999, with much of the interior furnishings donated by the community. Over the years many improvements and furnishings were added by the generosity and activity of the Friends of the Library and community members. However, the modular building was not designed to last more than 20 years, and by 2006 the building was deteriorating. Brevard County increased the library budget to begin funding for constructing a permanent library to replace it, but in 2007 the library budget was cut by 10% and all library construction projects were eliminated.

In 2008, the Mims/Scottsmoor Library building began to suffer serious roof and floor deterioration. The roof needed replacing, but due to insufficient funds and the age of the building, the roof was repaired and given a protective coating instead. Rotten floor panels were replaced.

Revised Lease for the Mims/Scottsmoor Library

In 2014 the floor was deteriorating again—and, although repairs were made, the building's condition was only getting worse. Today, the building is 27 years old—7 years beyond its designed lifespan—and needs to be replaced.

After many months of discussions with members of the Mims/Scottsmoor community, Brevard County Managers, the Facilities department, and the School Board, we propose this new lease agreement to allow us to build a new permanent library at Pinewood Elementary.

This new lease will end the current joint-use arrangement and allow us to construct a permanent library of approximately 8,000 square feet in the parking lot of the existing library. When the new library is ready for occupancy, the library will move out of the existing building and into the new building. The School Board will vacate the existing building, which will then be demolished and made into parking for the new library.

The cost estimate for the entire project is \$1.9 million. It is anticipated that design services will begin in 2016 and construction dollars are anticipated to be available in the Library Services budget over the two Fiscal Years of FY 17 and FY 18. There is no impact to the County's General Fund.

The Fiscal Impact of the new lease would be a one-time payment of \$100,000 to School Board in exchange for a 50-year lease, renewable for 25 years and will defray their costs in relocating portables for early childhood learning classes currently housed in the existing Mims/Scottsmoor library. Actual payment would be made only after the construction project itself is approved by the Board. The funds for this action are from Library Services. There is no impact on the County's General Fund.

This item is only requesting approval to proceed with the new lease. We will come to the Board to request approval to proceed with the construction of the replacement library at some future date.

**LEASE AND JOINT USE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
SCHOOL BOARD AND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 15 day of December 2015, by and between the School Board of Brevard County, Florida, a public corporation and governing body of the School District of Brevard County, duly created in accordance with Article IX, Section 4(b) Florida Constitution, and Chapter 320, Florida Statutes, hereinafter referred to as the "SCHOOL BOARD," and the Board of County Commissioners of Brevard County, Florida, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "COUNTY."

WHEREAS, the COUNTY desires to replace the existing 14,200 square foot modular building that is on SCHOOL BOARD property at Pinewood Elementary School, located at 3757 Old Dixie Hwy, Mims, Florida, with a more permanent structure; and

WHEREAS, the existing building is shared by the COUNTY and the SCHOOL BOARD, with 9,100 square feet allocated to the COUNTY for use as the Mims/Scottsmoor Public Library (hereafter referred to as the "LIBRARY"), and 5,100 square feet allocated to the SCHOOL BOARD for use as a Community Education Center; and

WHEREAS, the proposed permanent LIBRARY will be approximately 8,000 square feet and will be for the exclusive use of the COUNTY; and

WHEREAS, the SCHOOL BOARD and the COUNTY are desirous of cooperating with each other in utilizing facilities for the education and enjoyment of children and adults; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of providing the best services with the least possible expenditure of public funds, cooperation between the COUNTY and the SCHOOL BOARD is necessary and desirable; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY, as governing body of the Brevard County Free Public Library District, is authorized to contract with local agencies for provision of library services in facilities; and

WHEREAS, said governing bodies are authorized by Chapter 57-1166 of the Special Acts of Florida to enter into mutual agreements with each other, and to do any and all things for the mutual benefit of each of said boards; and

WHEREAS, section 163.01, Florida Statutes, known as the Florida Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1969, permits any political subdivision of the State of Florida to exercise jointly with any other political subdivision of the State of Florida, any power, privilege, or authority which said political subdivision share in common and which each might exercise separately; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition, ownership, custody, operation, maintenance, lease or sale of real property are all permitted purposes of an interlocal agreement under the Florida Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1969.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the COUNTY and the SCHOOL BOARD do hereby agree to cooperate with each other in carrying out the above purposes, and to that end agree as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and correct and are deemed an integral part of this Agreement.
2. The SCHOOL BOARD will provide a ground lease to the COUNTY for the property with the aerial outline, legal description, and sketch attached as "Exhibit A."
3. In consideration of this lease, a one-time payment from the COUNTY of \$100,000 to the SCHOOL BOARD will be made on July 1, 2016.
4. Upon receipt of payment, the SCHOOL BOARD will have thirty (30) days to vacate the property by relocating the SCHOOL BOARD program from the existing Community Education Center to portable classroom buildings on other SCHOOL BOARD property.
5. The SCHOOL BOARD will allow the COUNTY to construct a new LIBRARY facility on the leased property. When the new LIBRARY is ready for occupancy, the COUNTY will close the existing LIBRARY and move into the new LIBRARY. The existing LIBRARY building will be demolished and a new parking lot for the LIBRARY will be constructed in this area.
6. The COUNTY shall coordinate as necessary with school staff to ensure that activities related to construction of the new LIBRARY, demolition of the existing LIBRARY and Community Education Center, and construction of the new parking lot do not interfere with school operations.
7. The COUNTY, at its expense, shall be responsible for the maintenance of the library building, parking lot, walkways and grounds within the leased area surrounding the LIBRARY, outside lighting, grounds sprinkler system, underground water lines and wastewater lines. The COUNTY reserves the right to use outside contractors for said maintenance work.
8. All tangible property purchased by the COUNTY for use at the LIBRARY shall remain under its control and responsibility, including responsibility for repair or replacement of said tangible property.
9. The COUNTY shall have exclusive control over the operation of the LIBRARY.
10. The COUNTY shall have exclusive control over the collection and disbursement of income attributable to the LIBRARY. The parties further agree and understand that all income, fines and penalties collected by the LIBRARY attributable to operation of the LIBRARY shall be held in a separate account, which funds shall be utilized solely for such purposes as requested by the Library Director and approved by the COUNTY.

11. In the event of partial or total damage by fire, or other natural disaster, at its option, the COUNTY may decide to reconstruct or relocate the LIBRARY. If appropriate, the replacement or repair of said damaged or destroyed property shall be initiated and completed as quickly as practical.

12. The COUNTY shall at all times maintain liability insurance in amounts of \$200,000 per claimant and \$300,000 per occurrence, or such higher limits as may be imposed by any future amendments to Section 768.28, Florida Statutes. Nothing in this agreement shall be deemed as a waiver of sovereign immunity of either of the parties beyond any statutory limited waiver which may have been or may be adopted by the Florida Legislature and nothing in this agreement shall inure to the benefit of any third party for the purpose of allowing any claim which would otherwise be barred under the doctrine of sovereign immunity.

13. This Agreement shall be for fifty (50) years, and may be renewed upon mutual consent of both parties for another twenty-five (25) years.

14. This Agreement is not assignable by either party.

15. No change, modification or waiver of any of the provisions or conditions of this Agreement shall be valid unless in writing, signed by a duly authorized representative for each party. Waiver of any breach of the Agreement, or failure to follow any provision of the Agreement, shall not be deemed a waiver of any other or subsequent breach, and shall not be considered to be a modification of the terms of this Agreement.

16. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida. In the event any portion of said Agreement is declared invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

17. This Agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties.

19. ATTORNEY'S FEES: In the event of any legal action to enforce the terms of this contract each party shall bear its own attorney's fees and costs.

20. This agreement shall take effect when adopted by the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY and the SCHOOL BOARD OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, and fully executed by their duly authorized representatives.


