NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Value Adjustment Board will reconvene on Wednesday, April 8, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. in the Government Center Atlantic Room, Building C 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, 2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Viera, Florida, for the purpose of considering whether to adopt as final decisions of all recommendations made by Special Magistrates on value petitions, homestead exemptions, late file personal exemptions, other exemptions, agricultural classifications, all other assessment appeals that were filed and heard before the Special Magistrates, and any other business that may come before the Board. The decisions may be made without public comment.

If any petitioner disagrees with the decision of the Value Adjustment Board, an appeal may be filed in Circuit Court. Pursuant to Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, if a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board with respect to any matter considered at such meeting, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose, may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. Such person may provide a court recorder, stenographer, or a tape recorder for such verbatim record.

In accordance with the Americans With Disabilities Act, if any person with a disability as defined by the ADA needs special accommodations to participate in this proceeding, he or she should contact the Brevard County Manager's Office at 321-633-2001 no later than two (2) business days prior to the proceeding.
