Requested Action:	It is requested the Board recognize and permit Bryan Koon, Director of the Florida Division of Emergency Management and Emergency Management Accreditation Program (EMAP) Commissioner, to present Brevard County Emergency Management with the earned accreditation by the Emergency Management Accreditation Program.					
Summary Explanation & Background:	<p>Brevard County Emergency Management has been granted full accreditation by the Emergency Management Accreditation Program (EMAP). Upon recommendation by the Program Review Committee, the EMAP Commission voted on Brevard County's accreditation at its meeting on October 14, 2016.</p> <p>Emergency management accreditation represents a significant achievement. To achieve accreditation, applicants must demonstrate through self-assessment, documentation, and peer assessment verification that its program meets the <i>Emergency Management Standard</i>. The emergency management program uses the accreditation to prove the capabilities of their disaster preparedness and response systems.</p> <p>The accreditation process evaluates emergency management programs on compliance with requirements in sixteen areas, including: planning; resource management; training; exercises, evaluations, and corrective actions; communications and warning; and administration. This forms the foundation of the nation's emergency preparedness system. EMAP is the only accreditation process for emergency management programs.</p> <p>To achieve accreditation, Brevard County Emergency Management and the supporting departments and agencies, took steps to document compliance within sixty-four industry-recognized standards and a peer-review on-site assessment by a team of EMAP trained assessors. Brevard County has been evaluated and recognized for compliance with standards certified by the American National Standard Institute (ANSI) in order to build safer communities through credible standards of excellence.</p> <p>Accreditation recognizes the ability of programs to bring together personnel, resources, and communications from a variety of agencies and organizations in preparation for and in response to a disaster of any type.
