ORDER DETERMINING CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS


THIS MATTER came before the Court on 3/11/2026 on the Petitioner's *ore tenus* Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records. The Court reviewed the court file and considered the argument of counsel. As such, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. This Order is being entered in a domestic relations matter, to wit: Modification of Stipulated Final Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage.
2. Pursuant to Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.420(c)(9)(A)(vi), confidentiality is required to avoid substantial injury to a party by disclosure of matters protected by a common law or privacy right not generally inherent in the specific type of proceeding.
3. The allegations contained in the second paragraph of 5E of the Supplemental Petition for Modification of Final Judgment, Motion for Psychological Evaluation/Social Investigation, Motion for Contempt, & Motion for Attorney's Fees & Costs (Docket Number: 90) filed on 8/18/2025, are found to be confidential and shall be exempt from public access under article I, section 24(a) of the Florida Constitution.
4. Confidentiality shall be maintained until further order of the Court.
5. The degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered hereby are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth herein.
6. No less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth herein.

7. The Clerk of Courts is hereby directed to publish this Order in accordance with Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.420(e)(4).
