MELANIE TIBBALS

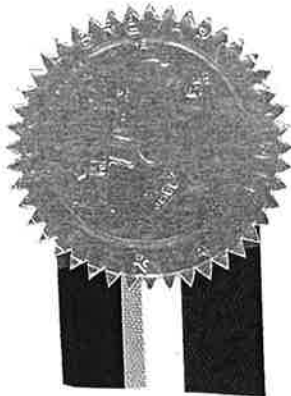
