THE PROPOSED BUDGET RECOMMENDS THE USER FEE RATES AS FOLLOWS:

CATEGORY: RESIDENTIAL	\$21.04	per acre or portion thereof
AGRICULTURAL	\$ 7.36	per acre or portion thereof
COMMERCIAL	\$40.85	per acre or portion thereof

THESE FEES ARE LEVIED IN ACCORDANCE WITH FLORIDA LAWS CHAPTER 01-336, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 03-334.
