WHEREAS, a diver on the VHS Swim/Dive team during 2014-2017, Ryan Just was a four-time Cape Coast Conference diving champion, three-time District runner up and 2017 District champion, four-time State medal winner, taking fourth place three years in a row, all four years he was undefeated against conference dive; and Ryan also swam on the 2017 200-Free Relay team which was Cape Coast Conference and District Champions; and

WHEREAS, Kevin Mall earned 10 letters in three sports and was the District, Regional, and Cape Coast Conference Champion and All-State in the Shotput; Florida Athletic Coaches Association All-District First Team and Player of the Year in football; Florida Today, All-Space Coast First Team and Orlando Sentinel Mid-East Super 60; he was selected to the United States Army All-American Bowl Combine and received a full scholarship to Fuman University; and Kevin is now in the United States Air Force Pilot Training program; and

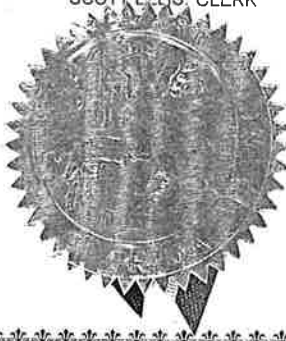
