In accordance with Resolution 2014-219 Section VIII (8.1) the agenda shall provide a section for public comment limited to thirty (30) minutes following approval of the consent agenda during each regular County Commission meeting. Individuals delivering public comment shall be restricted to a three-minute time limit on their presentation. Any speaker not heard during the first thirty (30) minute segment will be heard during a second public comment segment held at the conclusion of business specified on the regular Commission agenda. With the exception of emergency items, the Board will take no action under the Public Comment section, but can refer the matter to another meeting agenda.
