## IN RE: COURT COSTS - Insurance Coverage in Seminole County Court

Persons who have been assigned community service by the County Court of Seminole County as a condition of probation or otherwise, need medical insurance while performing such community service. Costs of such coverage as of June 3, 1994 has been determined to be \$3.95 for each fifty (50) hours of community service, or portion thereof. It is thereupon

ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That persons required to perform community service as a condition of probation or otherwise, by the County Court of Seminole County, shall have costs of \$3.95 for each fifty (50) hours of community service, or portion thereof, imposed by Court Order in the following or similar manner: "Within fifteen (15) days you will pay the Clerk of Circuit Court additional court costs in the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_\_to provide medical insurance coverage while you are performing community service required by Court Order."
- Clerk of the Court shall collect these funds in the 2. same manner as other court costs, and shall distribute these costs weekly to Community Service #001-00-00-00-155-10-00-00. Account Insurance However, the initial Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00) of insurance premium payments shall be paid to the Clerk and distributed into Community Service #001-00-00-00-202-12-00-00. Insurance Account These costs are imposed automatically, and require no specific Order of Court at time of sentencing.
