## IN RE: GRAND JURY EMPANELMENT

WHEREAS, section 905.01(3), Florida Statutes, states: "The chief judge of each circuit court shall regularly order the convening of the grand jury for a term of 6 months," and rule 2.215, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, authorizes the chief judge to enter administrative orders to further the administration of justice in the circuit;

IT IS ORDERED, Pursuant to section 905.01(3), Florida Statutes, there shall be a Grand Jury empaneled in each county of the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit every six months, serving for a term of six months as follows:

Brevard County: Spring Term beginning the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of March

Fall Term beginning the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of September

Seminole County: Spring Term beginning the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of April

Fall Term beginning the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of October
