IN RE: PROBATE & GUARDIANSHIP - WAIVER OF FINGERPRINTING FOR SPECIFIC GUARDIANS

Pursuant to Administrative Order 07-36-B, in accordance with the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, and section 744.3135, Florida Statutes, which provides, in part, that the Court may order guardians and shall require professional guardians to submit, at their own expense, to an investigation of his or her criminal background;

Whereas, any individual who is fingerprinted and whose prints are not discernable, as informed by the Clerk of Court, may have his or her fingerprints waived.

Whereas, the Court held a hearing on December 19, 2008, and found that fingerprints of Elizabeth Shea of Case Management and Counseling Services of Brevard, professional guardian, were not of sufficient quality to run records checks,

Therefore, It is hereby ordered that that the fingerprinting requirement are hereby waived, for all cases involving the professional guardian, Elizabeth Shea of Case Management and Counseling Services of Brevard.
