WHEREAS, Governor Ron DeSantis signed into law on July 1, 2019, CS/CS/CS/HB 385 - Transportation Bill which states, "that portion of U.S.1 (70030000) between E. Main Street and Parrish Bay Road is designated as the "Trooper Halley Strickland Memorial Highway"; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 1954, Trooper Strickland was tragically killed in the line of duty as the result of a single vehicle crash.





WHEREAS, the Florida Highway Patrol requested that the Board of County Commissioners support legislation to designate a portion of Babcock Street, between Malabar Road and Palm Bay Road, as the "Trooper Joseph Sawtell, Jr. Memorial Highway"; and

WHEREAS, Section 334.071, Florida Statutes, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to adopt a resolution in supporting honorary road designations within the County; and

WHEREAS, Governor Ron DeSantis signed into law on July 1, 2019 CS/CS/CS/HB 385 – Transportation Bill which states, "that portion of Babcock Street (70012000) between Malabar Road and Palm Bay Road is designated as the "Trooper Joseph Sawtell, Jr. Memorial Highway"; and

WHEREAS, on August 5, 1966, Trooper Sawtell was tragically killed in the line of duty when his patrol car was struck by another vehicle that ran a stop sign on Babcock Street in Palm Bay.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:


