**ANNE GORMAN**

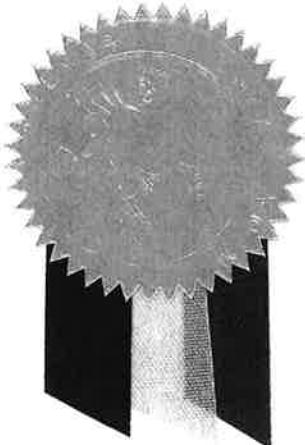
