WHEREAS, Viera High School (VHS) will host their Inaugural Athletic Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony on Saturday, December 8, 2018, and as a result of their outstanding individual accomplishments, the following athletes have been selected for enshrinement as members of the VHS Athletic Hall of Fame; and

WHEREAS, 3-time Class 3A State Champion 1M Diver Sarah Rousseau: Sarah won the State 1M Diving title in 2015, 2016, 2017 along with region, district, and CCC titles four consecutive years, and she attends the University of Missouri where she is a diver for the women's diving team; and

WHEREAS, 2-time Girls Tennis Class 3A Doubles State Champions Sasha Belaya and Izzie Diaz: This tandem earned two state titles in Class 3A in 2016 (4-6, 6-4, 10-1) and 2017 (7-5, 6-1); this dynamic duo was undefeated in doubles play during their playing career together; and Sasha attends the University of Illinois and is playing tennis for the nationally ranked University of Illinois, and Izzie attends Eastern Florida State College and also plays women's tennis; and

WHEREAS, Greg Young: 2-time Former Florida Today Bowler of the Year bowling 300 multiple times and won two national championships at McKendree University and currently is a professional bowler for Brunswick; and

WHEREAS, David McKay: Played baseball for Viera from 2009-2013 where he holds records for season strikeouts (91), strikeouts/game (10.4), innings pitched/season (61), doubles/season (12), and also holds the record for career games/played at the varsity level (107); David went on to pitch at Florida Atlantic University and was drafted by the New York Mets in 2013 and Kansas City Royals in 2016; and he currently plays for the Double AA Arkansas Travelers/Seattle Mariners; and

WHEREAS, former Girls Soccer Coach Courtney Lundy: Coach Lundy coached the Viera Girls Soccer Program for five years and the success was unprecedented; Coach Lundy was instrumental in building a consistent winner earning 2 Class 4A State Championships in 2015 and 2016, as well as the Topdrawersoccer.com; and Winter season National Champion in 2016, and she garnered Florida Dairy Farmers Class 4A Coach of the Year honors 2x as well as NFHS Coach of the Year honors; and

WHEREAS, 2014-15 Class 4A Girls Soccer State Championship Team: Earned the Class 4A State title defeating Navarre in the semifinals 2-0 and Pembroke Pines Charter 4-0 in an impressive State Finals victory; and members include: Morgan Pulliam, Alyssa Whisel, Mollie Roe, Jordan Walsh, Julia Ramsey, Hollyn Knight, Natalie Bertran, Sarah Sanford, Brookelyn Walsh, Cori Fisher, Hannah Dearing, Sarah Kelliher, Hope Leonard, Anna Martin, Emily Bodi, Shannon Gosule, Tori Clark, Nicki Fisher, Emily Ramsey, Cassidy Mills, Sydney Lau, and Alexandra Capalbo; and

WHEREAS, The Viera Company: Responsible for the community vision of Viera and the land that Viera High School resides; the community of Viera is an embodiment of a long-standing vision of the Duda family demonstrating the quality of a new type of development; Duda was founded in 1926 farming celery; in the early 1940's a 43,000 acre tract of land was purchased in Brevard County, and in 1989, the master plan for Viera was announced and it has been growing ever since. and commends them for the outstanding examples they have set for the student athletes of today.



WHEREAS, 2-time Girls Tennis Class 3A Doubles State Champions Sasha Belaya & Izzie Diaz earned two state titles in Class 3A in 2016 (4-6, 6-4, 10-1) and 2017 (7-5, 6-1). This dynamic duo was undefeated in doubles play during their playing career together. Sasha attends the University of Illinois and is playing tennis for the nationally ranked University of Illinois and Izzie attends Eastern Florida State College and also plays women's tennis; and

WHEREAS, 2-time Former Florida Today Bowler of the Year, Greg Young, bowled a score of 300 multiple times and won two national championships at McKendree University and currently is a professional bowler for Brunswick; and

WHEREAS, David McKay played baseball for Viera from 2009-2013 where he holds records for season strikeouts (91), strikeouts/game (10.4), innings pitched/season (61), doubles/season (12), and also holds the record for career games/played at the varsity level (107). David went on to pitch at Florida Atlantic University and was drafted by the New York Mets in 2013 and Kansas City Royals in 2016.
