be in effect for the period of July 1, 1998 - June 30, 1999.

Whereas the circuit judges in a special meeting held on January 14, 1998 decided the division structure and assignments for the Circuit Court of the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit in and for Brevard County beginning July 1, 1998, the structure and assignments beginning July 1, 1998 will be as follows:

1. <u>CRIMINAL DIVISION</u>

2. <u>JUVENILE DELINQUENCY DIVISION</u>

3. <u>CIVIL/FAMILY DIVISION</u>

(As Judge Pound has resigned effective June 1, 1998, his appointed successor would be assigned to the Civil Family Division during the remainder of the term. As Judge Jackson has resigned effective December 31, 1998, his elected successor would be assigned to the Civil/Family Division for the remainder of the term.)

4. <u>JUVENILE DEPENDENCY/PROBATE</u>

Judge Edward J. Richardson

Judge Richardson will receive all probate cases effective July 1, 1998. Effective immediately upon the signing of this order, the general civil cases will be divided into equal one sixths and be assigned to Judge Richardson, Judge Evander, Judge Jackson, Judge Jacobus, Judge Lober, and Judge Pound. Effective July 1, 1998, Judge Richardson will receive all probate cases. Judge Moxley will retain all pending probate cases set for trial or previously set for trial and continued. (A list of these cases will be provided to the clerk of the court) Judge Moxley will receive all pending civil cases assigned to Judge Richardson.

5. Chief Judge John Dean Moxley, Jr., will retain all guardianship cases and be assigned all new guardianship cases. Judge Edward J. Richardson will be available in addition to Judge Moxley to conduct hearings on emergency temporary guardianship and hearings on other matters of an emergency nature pertaining to

guardianship cases. Judge Moxley will also receive the civil cases assigned to Judge Richardson and receive one sixth of the general civil cases filed on July 1, 1998 and thereafter.

Judge Jerry E. Lober will receive the existing civil/family caseload of Judge J. Preston Silvernail, and Judge J. Preston Silvernail will receive the existing criminal caseload of Judge Jere E. Lober effective July 1, 1998.
