**WHEREAS**, At any given time in Florida, there are over 86,000 adults incarcerated in state prison and more than 146,000 adults are on felony supervision; and

**WHEREAS**, Individuals with a criminal history face significant barriers such as the inability to find housing, employment or education, volunteer in their community, and pay significant debt that arises because of their conviction and incarceration; and

**WHEREAS**, These barriers can contribute to recidivism, which increases victimization and decreases public safety; and
