ORDINANCE NO. 2017- 13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2016-07 GRANTING AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AD VALOREM EXEMPTION TO PROJECT MARATHON; AMENDING THE ADDRESS OF THE PROPERTY ADDRESS SPECIFIED FOR THE EXEMPTION; RATIFYING ALL OTHER PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE 2016-07; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA as follows:

Section 1. Sec. 102-235(a) of the Code of Ordinances of Brevard County, Florida is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 102.235.- Project Marathon

(a) An Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption is hereby granted to Project Marathon (hereafter referred to as "the Company"), for:

1. 100 percent a) of the assessed value of all improvements to real property made by or for the use of a new business (not to exceed the amount identified in the Company's amended application for exemption) as determined by the Property Appraiser for the first year after substantial completion of those improvements; and b) of the assessed value of all tangible personal property of such new business in place during that first year (not to exceed the amount identified in the Company's amended application for exemption), or
2. 100 percent a) of the assessed value of all added improvements to real property made to facilitate the expansion of an existing business in the first year of assessment after substantial completion of those improvements (not to exceed the amount identified in the Company's amended application for exemption) and b) of the assessed value of the net increase in all tangible personal property acquired to facilitate such expansion of an existing business during that first year (not to exceed the amount identified in the Company's amended application for exemption).

Section 2. Ratification- All other provisions set forth in section 102-235 of the Code of Ordinances of Brevard County, Florida are hereby ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Severability - If any provision of this Ordinance is held to be illegal or invalid, the other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date - This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon filing as provided by law. A certified copy of the Ordinance shall be filed with the Office of the Secretary of State, State of Florida within ten days of enactment.
