SUBJECT:	Request Approval of a Five (5) Month Extension of Crowder Gulf and Ashbritt, Inc. Contracts for Disaster Recovery/Debris Removal Services
DEPT/OFFICE:	Solid Waste Management Department

Requested Action:
 It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners grant a five (5) month extension of Crowder Gulf and Ashbritt contracts for Disaster Recovery/Debris Removal Services.

Summary Explanation & Background:

On August 21, 2012, the Board of County Commissioners approved contracts with Crowder Gulf and Ashbritt, Inc. for Disaster Recovery/Debris Removal Services. Each contract was for a term of five (5) years without an option for renewal, and is currently scheduled to expire August 20, 2017 during the middle of the hurricane season (June 1st - November 30th). By extending these contracts the new expiration date would be January 21, 2018.

The last contract negotiations extended beyond the time originally estimated. These same negotiations also resulted in a savings of over \$5.00 a cubic yard which greatly impacted the cost of Hurricane Matthew. In order to avoid any contract interruption during a potential hurricane or natural disaster, Brevard County and its citizens would be better served if the RFP for this contract was conducted during the off season. This would allow the County to award and negotiate the best contract possible while avoiding any interruption in disaster recovery/cleanup.

Fiscal Impact: The fiscal impact of extending both contracts cannot be determined at this time; however, the consequences of having these contracts expire during the time of a natural disaster would be detrimental to Brevard County and any disaster recovery and cleanup efforts.

Brevard county has spent \$10,733,991 for Hurricane Matthew under these contracts.

WHEREAS, the parties hereto entered into that certain five-year Agreement for Disaster Debris Removal Services on August 21, 2012, incorporated herein by reference; and


WHEREAS, the initial term of the Agreement for Disaster Debris Removal Services will expire on August 21, 2017; and




