### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the American Public Works Association (APWA) is an international, educational, and professional organization established in 1960, that works to promote and perpetuate the use of best practices with regard to public works related services; and

WHEREAS, the APWA continually works with national, state, and local agencies to improve public awareness with regard to efficient operation of public works systems and programs, including water, sewer, streets, highways, bridges, stormwater, public buildings, and solid waste collection. They will continue to play a key role in connecting community resources to improve quality of life and attain healthier communities; and

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Public Works (PW) Department mission is to plan and implement projects and services that create and maintain a comprehensive transportation and facilities infrastructure. The department maintains 1,142 miles of paved roads, 82 miles of dirt roads, 715 miles of sidewalk, 886 miles of curb and gutter, 951 miles of drainage ditches and swales, 17,310 drainage pipes, 49 bridges, 65,000 signs, 354 traffic signals, 667 street lights, 190 traffic warning beacons and school zone flashers, 1.8M square feet of County buildings and reimbursable support to an additional 2.6M square feet, and has more than 750 projects in progress; and

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Solid Waste Management Department mission is to protect public health by providing an efficient and environmentally sound Solid Waste Management System. The department handles 4,000 tons of solid waste per day, disposing 1,200,000 tons of waste per year in addition to over 1,000,000 tons per year diverted for recycling; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Brevard County Natural Resources Management Department is to foster sustainable use and stewardship of the County's natural resources through cost-effective, science-based, and consensus-driven management actions. The department sweeps 6000+ lane-miles of curbed streets, maintains 485 stormwater treatment facilities, performs 350+ illicit discharge inspections and 500+ inspections of petroleum/hazardous materials facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Utility Services Department continues to invest and renew assets for the benefit of public safety and the environment for generations to come. The department assures that all Federal and State environmental laws pertaining to water, sewer and reuse are met. Staff assist all of our water, sewer and reuse customers by mobilizing on-site and providing administrative assistance; and
