




WHO WE ARE

- Chartered to maintain safe navigation between the Atlantic Ocean and the Indian River Lagoon.


Sebastian Inlet District

- North - Brevard County
- South - Indian River County

- 2 Commissioners from Indian River


Responsible for sand bypassing onto downdrift beaches, safe navigation, and environmental resource protection.
