By approving this resolution and allowing the Constitution to stand on its own in its entirety, the commission is acknowledging the Constitution is the sole most important document in our country. Commissioner Isnardi has personally paid for framed copies of this resolution for each commission office at the expense of \$22.56 each.

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the United States is the cornerstone of our government and represents American values, and

WHEREAS, the first president of the United States and all subsequent presidents have sworn, as required by Article 2, Section 1 of the Constitution, "to preserve, protect and defend the Constitution of the United States," and

WHEREAS, local elected officials also swear to uphold the Constitution upon entering office and must understand that the Constitution is the standard against which all laws, policies, and interpretations should be measured, and

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners strongly believes that all provisions of the Constitution must be upheld without exception, not just sections popular with certain groups in certain times of history, and

WHEREAS, in recent years, the Board of County Commissioners has adopted resolutions to ensure the County follows all federal laws regarding immigration and to guarantee no action is taken to cause Brevard County to become a sanctuary County, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has recognized the right to bear arms by allowing employees to carry concealed weapons while at work in appropriate circumstances, and

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners will not waiver when it comes to preserving and protecting all of the rights provided to the American people in the Constitution and the Bill of Rights at all times.
