It is requested that the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners acknowledge the receipt of the Economic Development Commission of Florida's Space Coast's Bi-Annual Financial Report for their expenditures from October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023 and the Fiscal Year End 22/23 Economic Development Metrics.

Summary Explanation and Background:

On May 30, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners approved the Grant Agreement between Brevard County and the Economic Development Commission. This Agreement requires the Economic Development Commission to submit a bi-annual report to the County Manager providing the amount of County Grant funds expended to fulfill the requirements in the County's Grant Agreement.

According to the agency's bi-annual financial report, the agency has spent \$1,400,050 of the grant funds provided by the County during FY 2022/2023. These funds have been spent in the following categories: Marketing & Communications Programs, \$128,242; Facilities & Occupancy, \$136,350; General Administration, \$38,282; Personnel, \$1,028,366; and Professional Services, \$68,810.

Per Board action on September 5, 2023, the grant award for FY 2023/2024 has been reduced by 10%.






