

Approval Re: Construction Agreement and Lease Amendment with Fawn Lake Community Association, Inc. – District 1 (Fiscal Impact: Estimated at \$200,000)

#### SUBJECT:

Approval Re: Construction Agreement and Lease Amendment with Fawn Lake Community Association, Inc.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

FY2019 - \$200,000 is budgeted in the District 1 MSTU Fund 1131/262110.

#### **DEPT/OFFICE:**

Public Works

#### REQUESTED ACTION:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners approve and authorize the Chair to execute the Construction Agreement and Lease Amendment with Fawn Lake Community Association, Inc. and approve any necessary Budget Change Requests associated with this action.

## SUMMARY EXPLANATION and BACKGROUND:

The County was granted an easement for drainage canal maintenance over the Six Mile Creek which is located in part on property now owned by the Fawn Lake Community Association, Inc. In 1983, the County entered into a ninety-nine year lease agreement on lands now owned by the Association for a water retention pond. The terms of the lease required that the County construct the culvert pipe under what is now known as Fawn Lake Boulevard. The metal culvert pipe is now structurally failing and causing the road owned by the Association to fail. The lease between the parties is unclear as to the maintenance responsibility of the metal culvert pipe after the initial construction. The Association sought County assistance in replacing the failing metal culvert pipe under Fawn Lake Boulevard. Furthermore, the County desires a release of any maintenance responsibility for maintaining the culverts in the easement area now and into the future.

The Construction Agreement and Lease Amendment provides for the replacement of the failed culvert pipe and outlines the financial contribution by the Association and County. The County will provide the engineering and permitting services for the culvert pipe replacement. The Association will procure, at its own expense, a pre-fabricated concrete box culvert approved by the County. Furthermore, the County will perform the demolition;

installation of the box culvert, wing walls, and guardrails; and earthwork related to the culvert pipe replacement. The Association will reconstruct portions of Fawn Lake Boulevard to its original condition prior to the culvert pipe failure at their own expense. It is anticipated that the County's portion of the culvert replacement is approximately \$200,000.00. County forces from Road and Bridge Construction will be utilized for the culvert replacement work.

The Construction Agreement and Lease Amendment will also serve to amend the lease. The County and Association agree that the aforementioned easement does not create any maintenance obligations on the part of the County. The Association agrees that in exchange for the replacement of the culvert pipe under Fawn Lake Boulevard, the Association shall forever release the County from any liability and maintenance obligations for the box culvert, wing walls, earthwork, road surface and support over and under Fawn Lake Boulevard. The Association assumes all maintenance responsibility for all roadways, culverts (including over and under Amy Way), earthwork, and drainage improvements within the Fawn Lake Subdivision not designated as County Maintenance Areas in Attachment "B" of the Construction Agreement and Lease Amendment.

# CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT AND LEASE AMENDMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this <u>26</u> day of <u>FEB</u>. <u>2019</u> by and between the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD, COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and FAWN LAKE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC., a Florida not for profit corporation having a principal address of P.O. Box 173, Mims, Florida 32754, and its successor and assigns, hereinafter referred to as the "ASSOCIATION".

# WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the COUNTY was granted an easement for drainage and water control system purposes over the Six Mile Creek as recorded in ORB 2208, Page 117, hereinafter referred to as "EASEMENT", which is located in part on property now owned by ASSOCIATION.

WHEREAS, the COUNTY entered into a ninety-nine (99) year lease agreement with option to renew for an additional ninety-nine (99) years, hereinafter referred to as "LEASE", for lands now owned by ASSOCIATION for water retention and drainage control purposes in 1983 as recorded in ORB 2411, Page 2048 and as recorded in ORB 2428, Page 0927 to correct the legal description; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the LEASE required the COUNTY to construct the culvert pipe under what is now known as Fawn Lake Boulevard.

WHEREAS, the metal culvert pipe constructed in the drainage canal for Fawn Lake Boulevard is structurally failing and causing the road owned by the ASSOCIATION to fail; and

WHEREAS, the ASSOCIATION seeks COUNTY assistance in replacing the failing metal culvert pipe under Fawn Lake Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, drainage canals are necessary to maintain historical drainage flow so as to prevent flooding; and

WHEREAS, the LEASE between the parties is unclear as to maintenance responsibility of the metal culvert pipe under Fawn Lake Boulevard after the required initial construction; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY seeks clarification of the duties under the LEASE and seeks a release of any maintenance responsibility for maintaining the culverts in the EASEMENT area now and into the future; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY engineering staff has analyzed the culvert pipe under Fawn Lake Boulevard and found that replacement is the most reasonable alternative; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of one dollar and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. <u>RECITALS</u>: The recitals set forth hereinabove are true and correct in all respects and are incorporated herein by reference as if set forth herein verbatim.
- 2. <u>PROJECT</u>: The Project consists of the engineering, permitting, removal, and replacement of the failed metal culvert pipe under Fawn Lake Boulevard with a concrete box culvert and associated wing walls subject to the following:
  - a. COUNTY shall provide engineering and permitting for the work described below. Permits shall be obtained on behalf of and in the name of Fawn Lake Association. Association to sign permit documents as necessary.
  - b. ASSOCIATION shall procure a pre-fabricated concrete box culvert subject to the following requirements:
    - i. Provide engineered, signed and sealed shop drawings to be submitted to the COUNTY for review and approval.
    - ii. Box culvert to meet July 2018 FDOT Specifications and FDOT FY 2018-19 Standard Plans Indices 400-291 and 400-292.
    - iii. All box culvert materials are to be delivered to site and pass initial inspections by the COUNTY prior to being removed from the truck.
    - iv. Box culvert shall be constructed of Class IV (5500 PSI) concrete.
  - c. COUNTY shall demolish damaged pavement necessary to facilitate the construction of the Project at COUNTY'S sole determination and remove failed culvert pipe. Haul off debris and excess materials as necessary.
  - d. COUNTY shall install ASSOCIATION-provided precast concrete box culvert.
  - e. COUNTY shall furnish and install culvert wing walls.
  - f. COUNTY shall furnish and install guardrails
  - g. COUNTY shall backfill and compact box culvert with suitable onsite materials.
  - h. COUNTY shall fine grade roadway subgrade and stabilize surrounding area.
  - i. ASSOCIATION shall reconstruct portions of Fawn Lake Boulevard to its original condition prior to culvert pipe failure.
- 3. <u>CONSTRUCTION OF PROJECT</u>: The COUNTY agrees to undertake the replacement of the failed culvert pipe under Fawn Lake Boulevard with a concrete box culvert. ASSOCIATION will provide a box culvert at its own expense to COUNTY for construction of the Project as outlined in this Agreement. Financial contribution by the COUNTY for the Project is limited to the aforementioned items listed in Paragraph 2: a, c-h only.
- 4. <u>BOX CULVERT</u>: ASSOCIATION shall at its own expense purchase and provide a box culvert suitable for the construction of the Project as outlined in paragraph 2 above. Construction standards, specifications, and suitability of the box culvert shall be in the sole discretion of the Public Works staff of the COUNTY. ASSOCIATION will also allow COUNTY staff to coordinate the delivery date and delivery method of the box culvert to the Project location. COUNTY has reviewed engineering drawings for the previously manufactured box culvert the ASSOCIATION intends to purchase for this Project. COUNTY approves the box culvert attached as Attachment "A" to this Agreement so long as the box culvert is delivered to the Project site as set forth in paragraph 2.b.iii above. ASSOCIATION understands that time is of the essence in providing a suitable box culvert for construction. Should ASSOCIATION fail to timely provide a box culvert, or fail to provide a suitable or undamaged box culvert at the

discretion of COUNTY as directed by Public Works staff ASSOCIATION shall have 60 days to cure by acquiring a suitable replacement culvert. If ASSOCIATION fails to provide a suitable box culvert and COUNTY'S construction crew is mobilized and onsite constructing the project and such failure results in delay or demobilization of COUNTY'S work crew, ASSSOCIATION shall be responsible to bear the cost of any such delay or remobilizations costs. Should ASSOCIATION fail to cure as provided above, COUNTY shall be relieved of the responsibility of constructing the Project but all amended terms in Paragraph 7 of this Agreement as to future maintenance and release of maintenance terms under LEASE shall stand.

- 5. <u>PERMITTING</u>: ASSOCATION will cooperate with COUNTY staff, sign any required applications, and provide all necessary documentation to allow COUNTY to permit the new box culvert in the name of ASSOCIATION with St. Johns River Water Management District and any other necessary regulatory agencies.
- 6. <u>ROADWAY PAVEMENT</u>: ASSOCIATION understands and agrees that the reconstruction of Fawn Lake Boulevard after construction of the Project shall be the sole responsibility and expense of ASSOCIATION. ASSOCIATION further understands and stipulates that time is of the essence in reconstruction of Fawn Lake Boulevard as the box culvert, earthwork, and necessary support will not be stabilized by COUNTY in the Fawn Lake Boulevard roadway area after construction.
- 7. <u>LEASE AMENDMENT</u>: The parties hereby agree that the LEASE entered in ORB 2411, Page 2048 and as re-recorded in ORB 2428, Page 0927 to correct the legal description, shall be amended by recording of this CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT AND LEASE AMENDMENT in the public records of Brevard County, Florida to reflect the following:
  - a. ASSOCIATION hereby agrees that the EASEMENT recorded in ORB 2208, Page 117 does not create any maintenance obligations on the part of the COUNTY.
  - b. The ASSOCIATION hereby agrees that in exchange for the replacement of the culvert pipe under Fawn Lake Boulevard under the terms herein, ASSOCIATION and its successor and assigns shall forever release COUNTY from any liability and maintenance obligations for the box culvert, wing walls, earthwork, road surface and support over and under Fawn Lake Boulevard.
  - c. The ASSOCIATION hereby agrees that in exchange for the replacement of the culvert pipe under Fawn Lake Boulevard under the terms herein, ASSOCIATION shall forever release COUNTY from any liability, replacement and maintenance obligations it may or may not have had for the culvert, end walls, earthwork, guardrail, road surface and support over and under Amy Way. ASSOCIATION stipulates and agrees that ASSOCIATION is solely responsible for repair of the culvert, earthwork, wing walls, road surface and support over and under Amy Way.
  - d. COUNTY shall continue maintenance of the drainage canal and retention pond which are subject of the original LEASE and EASEMENT as depicted in Attachment "B" as Brevard County Pond Maintenance Area and Brevard County Canal Maintenance Area, incorporated hereto, except any improvements or structures placed by ASSOCIATION or residents of ASSOCIATION. Attachment "B" shall in no way alter the legal descriptions of the LEASE area as recorded in

- ORB 2411, Page 2048 and corrected in ORB 2428, Page 0927 nor the legal description of the EASEMENT area in ORB 2208, Page 117 but is solely provided to further define the maintenance responsibilities of the COUNTY.
- e. ASSOCIATION shall affirmatively assume all maintenance responsibility for all roadways, culverts, earth work, and drainage improvements within the Fawn Lake Subdivision not designated as County Maintenance Areas in Attachment "B".
- f. ASSOCIATION shall make all necessary repairs and replacements to the drainage improvements under Fawn Lake Boulevard and Amy Way as soon as reasonably possible as and when necessary so as not to damage COUNTY drainage facilities or hinder drainage flow through EASEMENT. All necessary repairs or replacements shall be done according to the latest edition of the Florida Department of Transportation Standard Specifications and COUNTY requirements.
- g. The ASSOCIATION shall provide the COUNTY with reasonable written notice of non-emergency repairs or replacements that would impair flow of water or could otherwise damage drainage structures within EASEMENT or LEASE area and shall provide plans and specifications for any such work as well as a written list of all contractors that will be performing work other than regular, routine maintenance for the ASSOCIATION pursuant to this Agreement. All repairs or replacement shall be subject to any applicable permitting requirements in effect at the time of the repair or replacement.
- h. All other terms of LEASE not in conflict with this amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
- 8. INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE. The ASSOCIATION agrees that it will indemnify and save harmless the COUNTY from any and all liability, claims, damages, expenses, proceedings and causes of action of every kind and nature arising out of or connected with the COUNTY'S portion of the Project or the ASSOCIATION's continued use, occupation, management or control of the Project area after construction of the Project, or any improvement placed thereon by the COUNTY or ASSOCIATION, or any equipment or fixtures used by the COUNTY or ASSOCIATION in connection with the Project. The ASSOCIATION agrees that it will, at its own expense, defend any and all actions, suits or proceedings which may be brought against the COUNTY in connection with any negligent, reckless, or intentional wrongful act or omission of the ASSOCIATION and persons employed or utilized by the ASSOCIATION as it relates to the Project, and that it will satisfy, pay and discharge any and all judgments that may be entered against the COUNTY in any such action or proceedings. acknowledge specific consideration has been exchanged for the provision. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be construed as a waiver of the COUNTY'S right to the protections of and/or caps on damages afforded by sovereign immunity under Section 768.28, Florida Statutes, or other limitations imposed on COUNTY'S potential liability under state or federal law.
  - a. The ASSOCIATION shall include in any contract for work upon or involving the EASEMENT and LEASE areas that the contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless ASSOCIATION and the COUNTY from liabilities, damages, losses and costs, including but not limited to attorney's fees, to the extent caused by the negligence, recklessness, or intentional wrongful misconduct of the contractor and persons employed or utilized by the contractor in the performance of the contract.

- 9. WARRANTY: Notwithstanding section 8 above, COUNTY shall warranty against defects in workmanship of the in-house design, engineering, and construction of the portions of the Project performed solely by the COUNTY for one (1) year from the date of substantial completion of the COUNTY'S portion of the Project. The COUNTY shall notify ASSOCIATION upon substantial completion of COUNTY'S portion of the Project. This provision shall not apply to materials or equipment normally expected to deteriorate or wear out and become subject to normal repair and replacement before their condition is discovered. The COUNTY shall not be required to do normal maintenance work under this warranty provision. This warranty specifically excludes any defects directly or indirectly caused by the box culvert procured by ASSOCIATION. This warranty shall apply only to such deficiencies as to which ASSOCIATION shall have given written notice to the COUNTY, as outlined in the notice provisions of this Agreement within the one (1) year period. Such notice must be given to COUNTY prior to any corrective action being taken by ASSOCIATION. The only remedy available to ASSOCIATION under this warranty is repair or replacement of the defective work performed by COUNTY. COUNTY shall have sole discretion to determine whether any repair or replacement shall be performed by COUNTY staff or outside contractors. This warranty does NOT authorize ASSOCIATION to contract for repairs and then seek reimbursement through a warranty claim with the COUNTY. Any outside repairs shall be at sole cost to the ASSOCIATION. ASSOCIATION understands and agrees that the aforementioned warranties are in lieu of all other warranties whether express or implied at law and with exception of the warranty expressly provided herein, all other warranties are waived. At least 30 days prior to the expiration of the warranty period, and on a date of the COUNTY'S choice during normal business hours, ASSOCIATION shall provide COUNTY staff access to the Project site to inspect and document the condition of the Project. COUNTY will provide engineering plans upon request to allow ASSOCIATION to perform due diligence and retain a licensed professional engineer of ASSOCIATION'S own choosing to review said plans prior to construction. ASSOCIATION will bear the cost of any such review. Any such review shall not delay the start of the Project. This Agreement is solely for the benefit of the formal parties to this Agreement and no right or cause of action shall accrue by reason hereof to or for the benefit of any third party not a formal party hereto.
- 10. <u>RIGHT OF ENTRY.</u> The COUNTY or its agents may enter in and on the ASSOCIATION property at any reasonable time for the purpose of inspecting such property, constructing the agreed upon improvements, or performing other duties as are required by law or by the terms of this Agreement. ASSOCIATION will be responsible for providing COUNTY a means of continuous access through the security gate during the construction of the Project.
- 11. <u>ASSIGNABILITY</u>. The ASSOCIATION shall not assign its responsibilities under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the COUNTY. In the event the ASSOCIATION does assign this Agreement, the ASSOCIATION and any such assigns shall be jointly and severally responsible for the ASSOCIATION's responsibilities under this Agreement.
- 12. <u>INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR</u>. The ASSOCIATION shall perform any services under this Agreement as an Independent Contractor and nothing herein shall be construed

to be inconsistent with this relationship or status. Nothing in the Agreement shall be interpreted or construed to constitute that the ASSOCIATION or any of its agents or employees to be the agent, employee or representative of the COUNTY.

- 13. RIGHT TO AUDIT RECORDS: In performance of this Agreement, the ASSOCIATION shall keep books, records, and accounts of all activities related to this Agreement in compliance with generally accepted accounting procedures. All documents, papers, books, records and accounts made or received by the ASSOCIATION in conjunction with this Agreement and the performance of this Agreement shall be open to inspection during regular business hours by an authorized representative of the COUNTY. The ASSOCIATION shall retain all documents, books and records for a period of five (5) years after termination of this Agreement, unless such records are exempt from section 24(a) of Article I of the State Constitution and Ch. 119, Florida Statutes. All records or documents created by or provided to the ASSOCIATION by the COUNTY in connection with this Agreement are public records subject to Florida Public Records Law, Chapter 119, Florida Statutes. All records stored electronically must be provided to the COUNTY in a format compatible with the information technology systems of the COUNTY.
- 14. NOTICE. Notice under this Agreement shall be given to the:

- 15. <u>WAIVER</u>. The waiver by the COUNTY of any of the ASSOCIATION's obligations or duties under this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of any other obligation or duty of the ASSOCIATION under this Agreement.
- 16. <u>ATTORNEY'S FEES AND NON-JURY TRIAL</u>: In connection with any litigation, including appellate proceedings, arising out of or under this Agreement, each party shall bear its attorneys' fees and costs and any trial shall be non-jury.
- 17. GOVERNING LAW. This Agreement and the interpretation and enforcement thereof shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.
- 18. <u>VENUE</u>. The venue of any litigation arising out of this Agreement shall be in a court of competent jurisdiction in and for Brevard County, Florida.


