

in Brevard County, and calls upon all citizens to recognize the white cane as an instrument of safety, and self-help for blind pedestrians on our streets and highways.

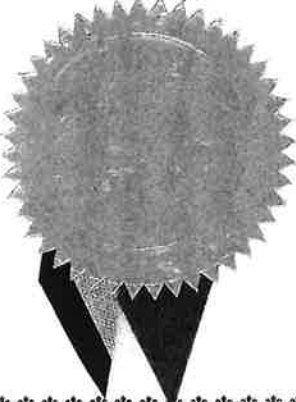
