BREVARD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

SUBJECT:	Approval of Purchase of One (1) Replacement Ambulance
DEPT/OFFICE:	Fire Rescue/Central Services

Requested Action:

Request the Board approve the purchase of one (1) replacement ambulance from Wheeled Coach Industries, an approved vendor selected through a competitive bidding process (Florida Sheriffs Bid #16-VEF12.0, specification 1) completed by the Florida Sheriffs Association, Florida Fire Chiefs Association, and Florida Association of Counties.

Summary Explanation & Background:

Fire Rescue Staff recommends utilization of the Florida Sheriffs Association, Florida Fire Chiefs Association, and the Florida Association of Counties bid to purchase this unit from Wheeled Coach Industries. The quote for this ambulance is \$158,730.00 and is attached. Funding for this capital purchase is from an approved Budget Change Request approved by the Board during the May 26, 2016 meeting (BCR Log # 20160301).

The Department continues to follow its Capital Replacement Plan for ambulance replacement. The goal of that Plan is to maximize the life cycle via unit rotation strategies and continued preventative maintenance. The Department's Rotation Plan moves units from high daily use to moderate use locations, then to a back-up status, and finally into retirement as a method of extending the overall life cycle. This strategy also ensures that only the most reliable units are utilized for front-line emergency response. It should be noted that back-up units are called into action on a daily basis while front-line units are being serviced or repaired. They are also called into service for special community events and during mass casualty incidents when a large number of units are needed for multiple patients. The Department's ambulances average well in excess of 200,000 miles and 10 years' service before they are finally retired from the fleet. By purchasing this replacement ambulance, the Department will continue to ensure continued reliability of our transport units when responding to emergencies.




