Requested Action:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners adopt a resolution congratulating the winners of the 2014 *Launch the Vote Student Art Contest*.

Summary Explanation & Background:

In preparation for the November 4, 2014 Election, Supervisor of Elections, Lori Scott announced the first annual 2014 Launch the Vote Student Art Contest for Brevard County 4th and 5th grade students. Supervisor Scott invited students to design a patriotic and nonpartisan image in conjunction with the Launch the Vote theme to encourage voter participation for the 2014 General Election. Each student was permitted to submit one entry to any of the four Elections Office locations by Friday, September 12, 2014.

In an effort to showcase Brevard's talented students and increase awareness about the importance of voting, the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winning art entries will be displayed at all of the Brevard Chick-fil-A locations during the month of October prior to the November Election. This contest will provide our future voters an exciting opportunity to participate in the election process and increase voter awareness for the General Election.

Supervisor Lori Scott, Representatives from Brevard's Chick-fil-A locations (including the famous Chick-fil-A Cow), and the student winners will participate in the awards presentation. Each student will receive a certificate and a prize package from Chick-fil-A.

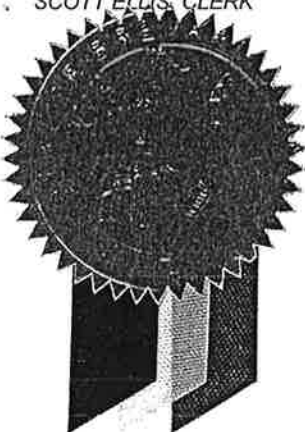

Artwork Guidelines:

- **All entries must be accompanied by a completed Launch the Vote Student Art Contest Entry Form available at www.VoteBrevard.com.**
- Entries must be submitted on an 8 ½ X 11 sheet of white paper or poster board with a horizontal orientation.
- Students may use as many colors or forms of media (print, crayon, felt pen, pencil, etc.) for the design. However, any material that makes the design three-dimensional will disqualify the entry.
- Due to the nonpartisan nature of the Supervisor of Elections office, designs that reference party affiliations, candidates or elected officials will be disqualified.
