Subject:

Board Consideration, Re: Appointment to the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee

Fiscal Impact:

Staffing for the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee is funded through State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Program grant funds and equates to approximately \$2,600 per year (for direct Committee support). There will be no impact to the General Fund.

Dept/Office:

Housing and Human Services

Requested Action:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners consider the application of John Hopengarten for the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee and consider his appointment as the member representing the Local Planning Agency pursuant to Section 163.3174.

Option 1: Appoint Mr. Hopengarten to the AHAC with a term that will expire on June 30, 2024.

Option 2: Direct staff to initiate procedures to readvertise the seat representing the Local Planning Agency and bring back a list of qualified candidates.

Summary Explanation and Background:

The Affordable Housing Advisory Committee (AHAC) is a state mandated board (Florida Statute 420.9076), which allows Brevard County to receive State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) funds. The AHAC makes recommendations to the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners on the allocation of funds from the state SHIP program, the Federal HOME Program, and other federal and state funds which allow the county discretion in the determination of housing priorities. Additionally, they review established policies and procedures, ordinances, land development regulations, and the adopted comprehensive plan of the county, in order to recommend specific actions or initiatives to encourage or facilitate affordable housing while protecting the ability of properties to appreciate in value.

The AHAC consists of members who represent specific categories, per the Statute, including one county resident who actively serves on a Local Planning Agency (LPA). The current AHAC Member who sits in this position has resigned from the Council. As part of the solicitation on the County Advisory Board website for vacancies, Mr. John Hopengarten applied indicating he could fit in several categories (see attached application) including this vacancy.
