**WHEREAS**, on average more than 700 people die each year in boating-related accidents in the U.S.; approximately 71% of these are fatalities caused by drowning; and

**WHEREAS**, the vast majority of these accidents are caused by human error or poor judgment, and not by the boat, equipment, or environmental factors; and

**WHEREAS**, 85% of boaters who lose their lives by drowning each year would be alive today had they worn their life jackets; and

**WHEREAS**, today's life jackets are more comfortable, more attractive, and more wearable than styles of years past, and deserve a fresh look by today's boating public.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA**, does hereby proclaim May 21 through May 28, 2016, as

**NATIONAL SAFE BOATING WEEK**

in Brevard County. As the season approaches, we encourage all to support the goals of the North American Safe Boating Campaign and the start of the year-round effort to promote safe boating, and urge all those who boat to "Wear it" and practice safe boating habits.
