

# Time extensions for three City of Melbourne Save Our Indian River Lagoon Cost-Share Agreements (Districts 3 & 4)

#### SUBJECT:

Time extension amendments for three City of Melbourne Save Our Indian River Lagoon Cost-Share Agreements (Districts 3 & 4)

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

This board action does not change the funding amount, only the timing of anticipated costshare distributions.

The combined value of the three subject agreements is \$756,042. Although the reimbursement amount is not changing, the timing of reimbursements may be delayed from FY 18-19 to \$322,200 in FY 19-20, \$347,781 in FY 20-21, and \$86,061 in FY 21/22.

### REQUESTED ACTION:

It is requested the Board 1) Execute time extensions for three City of Melbourne contracts, SOIRL 18-04, SOIRL 18-34, and SOIRL 18-35; 2) authorize the County Manager, or designee, to execute future amendments with fiscal impact less than \$100,000, subject to the approval of the County Attorney and Risk Management; and 3) approve associated budget change requests.

### SUMMARY EXPLANATION and BACKGROUND:

The Board of County Commissioners, in regular session on May 23, 2017, approved the 2018 update of the plan, adding these projects between the City of Melbourne and Brevard County for a septic to sewer conversion project and two stormwater projects funded through the Save Our Indian River Lagoon Trust Fund.

The City of Melbourne encountered homeowner participation issues in the Hoag Avenue septic to sewer conversion project (SOIRL 18-04), thus invalidating their FDEP permit. The City is seeking to modify their permit to move forward with the project and is requesting a two year and three month extension to December 31, 2021.

The City also encountered delays in land acquisition needed for the Cliff Creek baffle box project (SOIRL 18-34). They are requesting an eight month extension to May 31, 2020. The City had a delay in the Thrush Drive baffle box project (SOIRL 18-35) due to lack of

sufficient pre-project storm events needed to finish the design. They are requesting a one year extension to September 30, 2020.

### AGREEMENT NUMBER: SOIRL 18-04

THIS AMENDMENT entered into this <u>12</u> day of <u>Feb.</u>, 2019, by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Brevard County, Florida and The City of Melbourne.

WHEREAS, the parties have previously entered into that certain Save Our Indian River Lagoon Project Cost-Share Funding Interlocal Agreement No. SOIRL 18-04 ("ILA") on February 21, 2018; and

WHEREAS, due to lack of acceptance by one property owner to hook up to the force main the city is not meeting the FDEP permitting requirements and must pursue a different avenue, the parties desire to amend the Agreement to extend the timeline required to complete the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants herein contained, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Section 3. Terms and Extensions is amended to read as follows:
- a. The term of this Agreement is from the date upon which the last party has dated and executed the same ("Effective Date") until <u>December 31, 2021September 30, 2019</u> ("Completion Date"). CITY shall not commence the Project until any required submittals are received and approved. Time is of the essence for every aspect of this Agreement, including any time extensions.
- b. Any request for an extension of time beyond the Completion Date must be made in writing no less than 45 days prior to the contracted Completion Date. Timely requests to extend for longer than six months may only be approved by the Board of County Commissioners. Requests to extend for less than six months may be approved by the County Manager or his/her designee.
- c. Notwithstanding specific mention that certain provisions survive termination or expiration of this Agreement, all provisions of this Agreement that by their nature extend beyond the Completion Date, for example, delivery of a final progress report, will remain in full force and effect after the Completion Date as necessary to affect performance.
- 2. All terms and conditions of the Agreement, incorporated herein by this reference, not inconsistent with the provisions of this First Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect.
