Summary Explanation and Background:

On November 2, 2010 Brevard voters approved a referendum initiated through the Charter Review Commission for citizens to make recommendations improving efficiency and effectiveness to the Brevard County Board of Commissioners.

For the current annual cycle the Speak Up Brevard website opened on January 1st, 2025 to receive citizen suggestions through January 31, 2025. The proposed workshop is for the board to hear presentations from citizens that have submitted recommendations via the county website.

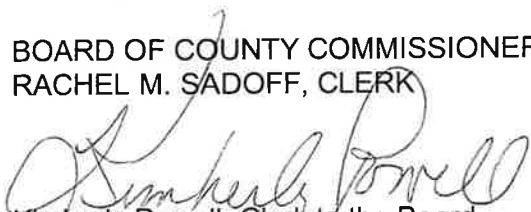

Speak Up Brevard



History



- Speak Up Brevard is known in the County Charter as the Citizen Efficiency and Effectiveness Recommendation (CEER)
- A proposal for a version of Speak Up Brevard came from the 2010 Brevard County Charter Review Commission and was adopted in November 2010
- This program invites residents to submit ideas and recommendations aimed at improving County efficiency and effectiveness.

Examples of 2024-Approved

Recommendations:

- Include Pickleball opportunities on the County’s website
- Adjusting the operating hours of the Port St. John Public Library

2024 Updates

Recommendations adopted by the Board of Commissioners in April 2024:

- Language reconciliation
- Change recommendation submission month from December to January
- Change evaluation deadline from 45 to 90 days
- Add administrative rejection recommendation option that provides County Manager option to recommend rejection for any CEER:
 - Not under County jurisdiction
 - That does not promote the efficiency and effectiveness of County government, such as personal service requests.

These recommendations will still be reviewed by the Board.



Speak Up Brevard Process



- **Submission Deadline**

- All recommendations for the current cycle must be submitted by **Jan. 31, 2025**.

- **Evaluation Period**

- The County Manager's Office and County Staff review submissions and provide comments to be presented to the Board of County Commissioners within 120 of the filing date as required by the Charter.

Commission Review



- Citizen recommendations, with staff evaluations, are presented to the Board of County Commissioners with the following voting options:
 - Approve
 - Reject
 - Accept with revisions

Recommendations to the Commission



- **Notification**

- Submitters will receive at least one week's notice prior to their recommendation being reviewed by the Board. Submitters may present at the meeting under this agenda item.

- **Transparency**

- A public listing of all past recommendations and their outcomes, as well as current recommendations, are available on the County's Speak Up Brevard website <https://sites.brevardcounty.us/SpeakUpBrevard/>
