Requested Action:

It is requested that, pursuant to Florida Statute 16.555(5)(b), the Board of County Commissioners authorize the Chairman to send a Letter of Agreement for the Crime Stoppers Trust Fund Grant designating the Central Florida Crimeline Program, Inc. to act as Brevard County's agent for the purpose of applying for and receiving funds from the Crime Stoppers Trust Fund.

Summary Explanation & Background:

Florida Statutes 16.555(3) establishes a trust fund for purpose of grant administration to fund Crime Stoppers and their crime fighting programs within the units of local government of the state. A grant may be awarded only to counties, which are served by an official member of the Florida Association of Crime Stoppers and may only be used to support Crime Stoppers and their crime fighting programs. In addition, only one official member is eligible to receive support within any county and they must be an authorized Crime Stoppers Program.

Therefore, the Sheriff's Office is requesting the Board of County Commissioners authorize the Chairman to send a Letter of Agreement to the Attorney General's Office authorizing the Central Florida Crimeline Program to act as Brevard County's agent.
