NATIONAL HOMELESS PERSONS MEMORIAL DAY

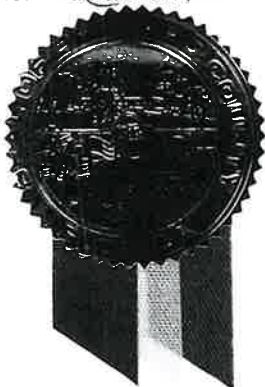
in commemoration of those who have passed and those currently facing the perils of homelessness.
