Approval, Re: Authorizing Resolution, Grant Application, Use of Toll Revenue Credits, Designation of Signature Authority and Execution of Follow-Up Master Grant Agreement with the Federal Transit Administration, FY2021/FY2022 Brevard County Transit Federal Capital and Operating Assistance Urbanized Area Grant

Requested Action:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners approve the following actions for the FY2021 Section 5307 Urbanized Formula Program, Capital and Operating Assistance Grant from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) in the amount of \$5,336,035:

- The Chair to sign the Authorizing Resolution,
- The Chair to sign the Grant Application,
- The use of Florida Department of Transportation Toll Revenue Credits,
- The Chair to sign the Designation of Signature Authority, allowing staff to submit the grant electronically,
- The Interim Transit Director to execute and submit the Grant Master Agreement electronically, contingent upon the County Attorney and Risk Management Approvals,
- The Interim Transit Director to execute any additional follow-up documentation, resolutions and amendments necessary to secure these funds,
- Authorize the County Manager to execute necessary budget change requests.

Summary Explanation and Background:

Each year Brevard County is apportioned Federal Transit Administration Capital and Operating Assistance under the Urbanized Area Formula Program as identified in 49 U.S.C. 5307. Space Coast Area Transit is applying for a total of \$5,336,035 for its FY2021-2022 Budget. This funding will come from the following apportionments: \$151,388 from FY2019 Titusville Urbanized Area, \$850,298 from FY2021 Titusville Urbanized Area, \$86,997 from FY2020 Palm Bay/Melbourne Urbanized Area and \$4,247,352 from FY2021 Palm Bay/Melbourne Urbanized Area.

When Congress passed the American Rescue Plan Act earlier this year, Brevard County's Urbanized Areas were apportioned additional operating assistance for FY2021-2022; therefore staff did not place any operating assistance into this year's Section 5307 grant. Staff will be submitting authorizing for application of the

American Rescue Plan apportionment under a separate Agenda item.



RESOLUTION authorizing the filing of application(s) with the Department of Transportation, United States of America, for grant(s) under the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended.

WHEREAS, the Secretary of Transportation is authorized to make grants for a mass transportation program of projects and budgets; and

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs in the program; and

WHEREAS, it is required by the U. S. Department of Transportation in accord with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, that in connection with the filing of an application for assistance under the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended, the applicant gives an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U. S. Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the applicant that minority business enterprise be utilized to the fullest extent possible in connection with these project(s), and that definite procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that minority business shall have the maximum construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or consultant and other services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,

1. That the Chair, Brevard County Board of County Commissioners, is authorized to execute and file application(s) on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners, Brevard County, Florida, with the U. S. Department of Transportation to aid in the financing of planning, capital and/or operating assistance projects pursuant to Section 9 of the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended.

PROJECT JUSTIFICATION

SCOPE: PURCHASE REPLACEMENT BUS

Replacement Bus – 11.13.03

Staff will purchase (1) 30' vehicle. This vehicle will be used to replacement one bus that was totaled in an accident.

SCOPE: BUS SUPPORT FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

Rehab/Renov Security System – 11.34.07

Staff will continue to update all current buses with high definition cameras to correspond with the new Intelligent Transportation System and repair any malfunctioning systems.

Engineering and Design/Admin Building – 11.42.03

Staff will make renovations to the North and South Terminal, which will require Engineering and Design services.

ADP Hardware – 11.42.07

Staff will continue to purchase new computers and replace existing computers to correspond with the new Intelligent Transportation System. Additionally, staff rotates the replacement of the existing computers to assure all systems stay up to date.

ADP Software – 11.42.08

Staff will purchase software needed for route planning, driver scheduling, dispatching and necessary software for Administration and advertising/marketing throughout the year.

Security Equipment – 11.42.09

Staff will purchase and update security systems and replace malfunctioning systems for the two transit terminals.

Support Equipment – 11.42.20

Staff will be replacing equipment throughout dispatch, office and administration, as needed. All items will be under \$10,000, micro-purchases threshold under Federal financial assistance awards.

Rehab/Renovate Administration Facilities – 11.44.03

Staff will continue rehabilitation and renovation in accordance with the updated Transit Asset Management Plan for both terminals. Staff will also use funds for repairs needed to keep buildings and facilities in proper working order.

Lease Support Equipment – 11.46.20

Staff will continue to lease 3 copy machines for the support of administration, operations and finance.

SCOPE: BUS SIGNAL AND COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT

Radio/Communication Equipment - 11.64.03

Staff will replace radios, as necessary, for bus operations. Many have reached their end of their useful life. Staff will upgrade as necessary to ensure that the radio's compatible with EOC's new system.

Rehab/Renovate Radios – 11.64.03

Staff will rehabilitate radios that are necessary for bus operations.

SCOPE: OTHER CAPITAL PROGRAM ITEMS

Preventive Maintenance – Rolling Stock – 11.7A.00

Staff contracts bus and van preventative maintenance and fleet management with First Vehicle Services to perform maintenance at scheduled periods.

SCOPE: TRANSIT ENHANCEMENTS

Landscape/Scenic – 11.92.03

Staff will purchase landscaping for both Terminals and bus stop projects.

Acquisition of Signage and Maps – 11.92.08

Staff will purchase bus stop signage, bus stop map PVC boards, along with route maps and schedules for all routes.

Bus Shelters – 11.93.02

Staff will continue to build and improve bus stops and shelters throughout the County through interlocal agreements and construction contracts.

SCOPE: METROPOLITAN PLANNING

Short Range Planning – 44.24.00

These funds will be used to develop short range transit plans, such as Fare Policy Assessment, updates to Transit Development Plan and Cost Allocation Plan.
