SUBJECT:

Approval Re: Emergency Medical Services Impact Fee Advisory Committee for Benefit District 1 Recommendation (Districts 1 - 5)

FISCAL IMPACT:

FY17/18 – The funds for this appropriation have already been collected and are held in the Emergency Medical Services Impact Fee Trust Fund for Benefit District 1 (Fund 1330). They are currently budgeted as Capital Reserves. On April 23, 2018 the balance in Fund 1330 was \$400,797.17.

REQUESTED ACTION:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners approve the project funding recommendation as prepared by the EMS Impact Fee Advisory Committee for Benefit District 1 on April 20, 2018 and authorize the Budget Office to execute any budget changes required to implement project appropriations.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION and BACKGROUND:

On April 20, 2018 the EMS Impact Fee Advisory Committee for Benefit District 1 met and adopted the following recommendation:

- (1) Appropriate \$250,140.00 for the purchase of a Wheeled Coach Ford F350 Ambulance with a Physio-Control Life Pak 15, Stryker Power-PRO XT Stretcher, Stryker Stair Chair to be administered by the Brevard County Fire/Rescue.

The EMS Impact Fee Advisory Committee for Benefit District 1 consists of one

representative from the County, Cape Canaveral, Cocoa Beach, Grant/Valkaria, Indialantic, Indian Harbour Beach, Malabar, Melbourne, Melbourne Beach, Melbourne Village, Palm Shores, Palm Bay, Satellite Beach, Titusville and West Melbourne.
