

#### Ms. Abudu:

I write to you today neither as a fellow member of the Florida Bar nor in my capacity as Chair of the Brevard County Commission, but rather in my capacity as an individual County Commissioner.

It has been suggested that the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners consider the SPLC's designation of a particular organization as a "hate group" in allocating, to local entities, the over \$105M of federal CARES Act dollars provided to the County.

In reviewing your organization's website, I have been unable to identify, with specificity, the particular criteria utilized in your organization's determination of whether a group is properly classed a hate group. Would you please advise me of the process by which a group is added to your list, including the criteria and relative weight afforded to each variable?

Are the organizations added to your list contacted and provided an opportunity to rebut any allegations leading to their inclusion prior to their being added to your list of hate groups?

Your reply will certainly help tremendously in knowing how much consideration to afford to an organization being listed, by the SPLC, as a hate group.

I am confident that neither I nor any of my colleagues wish to allocate money to groups promoting violence or lawlessness. Assuming your criteria are sound and groups are afforded a reasonable degree of due process to challenge their inclusion, it would be tremendously helpful to have an existing resource upon which to rely.

I thank you in advance both for your reply as well as your help in exposing hateful ideology.
