Summary Explanation and Background:

This grant will enable Brevard County Transit Services the continued provision of essential curb-to curb transportation services to Transportation Disadvantaged (TD) residents as defined in Florida Statute 427, part 1. Funds in the Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund are allocated, on a formula basis to each County according to the Florida Administrative Code 41-2. The formula is based on a comparative ranking of eligible recipients that includes the following categories: Transportation Disadvantaged eligible population of the County; total centerline miles of public roads in the County; Transportation Disadvantaged trips provided; and the State's total allocated funding from the previous year.

Brevard County has been allocated \$1,816,703 in State Fiscal Year 2025-2026 TD Trust Funds, including the required 10% local match.
