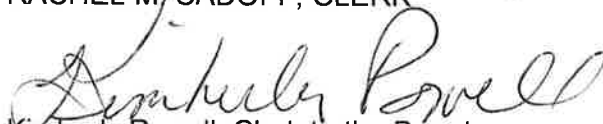

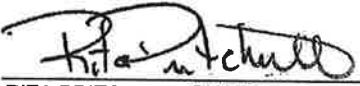

FAMILY

SPIRIT OF THE LORD WE PRAY YOU:

Psalms 33:12 ...America would be known and blessed as a nation whose God is the Lord, and a faithful people whom He has chosen for His own inheritance.

Psalms 89:14 ...America's foundations would align with the righteousness and justice in the foundation of God's throne; lovingkindness and truth will surround us as Christ's love, life and liberty are found in us.

ART, MEDIA, & ENTERTAINMENT

PRAY THAT THE SPIRIT'S GIFTS AND FRUIT WOULD FILL THIS INFLUENTIAL INDUSTRY SO THAT:
