Subject:

Submittal to Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Grant for Utility Services Projects

Fiscal Impact:

Seeking \$2.5M for a FDEP grant with an additional \$2.5M matching from Brevard County Utility Services Department for a total of 2 grant requested projects.

Dept/Office:

Utility Services

Requested Action:

Approval to apply for above mentioned grants, and to utilize Brevard County Utility Services funds for grant matching funds.

Summary Explanation and Background:

Florida Department of Environmental Protection is accepting grants associated with Indian River Lagoon Water Quality Improvements and resilience with the deadline for submittals being August 31, 2023. The two grants Utility Services is requesting to submit are: (1) F-01 & F-04 Lift Station Replacement and (2) Sykes Creek Sewer and Manhole Lining.

Lift Station F-01 & F-04 are located adjacent to the Indian River Lagoon serving over 400 customers. The lift station projects are shovel ready and estimated to cost approximately \$3M to complete. The Sykes Creek Sewer and Manhole Lining is resiliency project to minimize inflow and infiltration reducing the probability of discharges to the Indian River Lagoon. Estimated effort for the continuation of the lining program in Sykes Creek is \$2M.
