Board discussion on declining to move forward on a policy amendment to reimburse employee expenses related to concealed carry permits.

### **Summary Explanation and Background:**

On October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021, after discussing the potential for reimbursing employees for expenses related to obtaining a permit to carry a concealed weapon pursuant to Florida law, the Board directed staff to further investigate the impact of such a policy change.

The Brevard County Human Resources Department, in conjunction with the Brevard County Attorney's Office, accomplished this research. They found that there is the potential for significant detrimental consequences to the County in implementing such a regime. As such, it is requested that the Board decline to move forward with the policy amendment previously suggested.


