AN ORDINANCE OF THE BREVARD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, DISSOLVING THE BREVARD COUNTY COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY KNOWN AS THE "MERRITT ISLAND REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY" LOCATED ON MERRITT ISLAND, FLORIDA; DISSOLVING THE "MERRITT ISLAND REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY" TRUST FUND, ADVISORY BOARD, COMMITTEES AND REDEVELOPMENT PLANS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners on October 4, 1988, adopted Resolution 90-188 for the purpose of creating the "Merritt Island Redevelopment Agency"; and

WHEREAS, the Merritt Island Redevelopment Agency is comprised of areas of Merritt Island in unincorporated Brevard County; and

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners, on December 9, 1991, adopted Ordinance No. 91-39, which amended Ordinance 88-37 to add land to the redevelopment area; extending the boundaries of the redevelopment area to consist of additional property eastward and adjacent to the Merritt Island Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners, on May 16, 2006, adopted Ordinance 06-32, which amended Ordinance 91-39 to continue the Merritt Island Redevelopment Agency and provided legal description of the additional area to be included within the community redevelopment area; and

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners, on August 19, 2014 amended Ordinance 06-32 and adopted Ordinance 14-21 and Ordinance 14-22, to continue the Merritt Island Redevelopment Agency and approved an extension to the community development area; and

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners has determined that the Merritt Island Redevelopment Agency has fulfilled its original intent and it is no longer in the best interest of the residents, visitors, and businesses of the County to maintain the Merritt Island Redevelopment Agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BREVARD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Merritt Island Redevelopment Agency is hereby dissolved pursuant to the authority contained in Chapters 163 and 189, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. The Merritt Island Redevelopment Agency, all adopted community redevelopment plans, advisory boards, and trust funds are similarly dissolved and of no remaining effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
