SUBJECT:	Legislative Intent and Permission to Advertise; Re: Amendments to Sec. 102-122(a) of the Code of Ordinances of Brevard County, Florida.

Requested Action:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners approve Legislative Intent and grant staff permission to advertise for a public hearing to consider amendments to Sec. 102-122 of the Code of Ordinances of Brevard County, Florida.

Summary Explanation & Background:

Legislative Intent: State law allows tourist development tax ("TDT") revenues to be used for a number of purposes and projects outlined in Section 125.0104, Florida Statutes, also known as the Local Option Tourist Development Act ("Act"). This Act also provides that revenues to be derived from the TDT may be pledged to secure and liquidate revenue bonds issued by counties to fund certain purposes and projects. *See*, Section 125.0104(5)(d), Florida Statutes. The proposed amendments to Sec. 102-122(a) of the Code of Ordinances of Brevard County, Florida, will update and conform County Code to statutory purposes and projects set forth in the current version of Section 125.0104(5)(d), Florida Statutes.

Upon granting Legislative Intent and Permission to Advertise, the Ordinance will be scheduled for future public hearing before the Board.
