Approval RE: Disbursement of Educational Facilities Impact Fees (Districts 1-5)

Fiscal Impact:

Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Disbursements to the School Board are currently budgeted at \$22,652,418, contingent on the actual collection amounts. This disbursement would allow for \$6,428,857.25 to be disbursed to the School Board.

Requested Action:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the disbursement of Educational Facilities Impact Fees in the amount of \$6,428,857.25 to the School Board of Brevard County in accordance with the terms of the interlocal agreement and authorize the Budget Office to execute necessary Budget Change Requests to implement this disbursement.

Summary Explanation and Background:

On April 11, 2022 the Impact Fee Advisory Committees for the North and South Educational Facilities Impact Fee Benefit Districts met and adopted project funding recommendations for consideration by the School Board. The Impact Fee Advisory Committees consist of one representative from each of the following: the Brevard County School Board, Brevard County and each municipality within the Benefit District that has entered into an interlocal agreement with the County to participate in the Educational Facilities Impact Fee Program.

The School Board approved the funding recommendations on April 26, 2022 to include the below projects -

Central Area Secondary - \$3,500,000 South Area Elementary School Capacity - \$1,133,809.94 North Elementary Capacity - \$1,095,047.31 Debt Service - \$700,000

Discussion

Brevard County collects educational facilities impact fees from residential development for construction of educational facilities or capital improvements that provide educational capacity in the Impact Fee Benefit District from which the funds were collected.

The funds may be used on capacity projects identified in the Five-Year District Facilities Work Program. The process by which funds are allocated to projects is outlined in the Interlocal Agreement between Brevard County and the School Board, Each Benefit District (North and South) has an Educational Facilities Impact Fee Benefit District Advisory Committee that includes the School Board, County and applicable municipal representatives. Approximately every quarter, the District Advisory Committees make a recommendation to the School Board. The School Board approves or modifies the recommendation and then submits the funding request to Brevard County for approval by the Board of County Commissioners. The process can take 2-4 months before the funds are received by the District.

The Board action requested allocates the impact fee revenue collected through the quarter ending March 31, 2021. The Impact Fee Benefit District Advisory Committees met on April 11, 2022. The Committees' recommendations for new educational facilities impact fees through March 31, 2021 are attached to this agenda memo and are summarized as follows:

- Central Area Secondary \$3,500,000
- South Area Elementary School Capacity \$1,133,809.94
- North Elementary Capacity \$1,095,047.31
- Debt Service \$700,000

The Central Area Secondary project includes funds that can be used for a classroom building addition at Viera High School as well as funds that can be used for a middle school on the site next to Viera High School (referred to as "Middle School X" in our Five-Year District Facilities Work Program). Both of the secondary projects were discussed at the November 16, 2021 School Board Workshop on capacity.

In this quarterly cycle, educational impact fees are allocated to provide funding for South Area Elementary School Capacity. At the recent School Board Workshop on March 22, 2022, a potential major project at West Melbourne Elementary School for Science is under development to create additional classroom capacity.

Additionally, a North Elementary Capacity project has been developed to provide an additional classroom building at South Lake Elementary School. This project intends to add an additional class to each grade level and provide more choice school capacity in the north area of Brevard. The South Lake building addition is currently in the design phase and the building is planned to open in August 2023. This project was also reviewed at the recent School Board Workshop on March 22, 2022.

Finally, the proposed allocation to debt service is \$700,000. When using educational impact fees to pay debt for prior construction of student stations, the debt must be related to a project within the impact fee benefit district from which the fees were collected. The Finance Department has confirmed that the proposed use of the funds is in compliance with this requirement as outlined in the Interlocal Agreement

and Florida Statutes. This allocation to debt service was not budgeted, so this will result in a reduction in the amount of capital funds used to pay debt service by \$700,000. Since this allocation to debt was not budgeted, the new capital funds available are recommended for the Mims Cafetorium project. Due to recent construction cost escalation and the state laws requiring Mims to be built as a hurricance shelter, we are adding some additional funds to this budget. This project is included in the approved Five-Year District Facilities Work Program and was discussed at the March 22, 2022 School Board Workshop on capacity.

Recommendation

Approve the recommendations of the Educational Facilities Impact Fee Benefit District Advisory Committees:

- Central Area Secondary \$3,500,000
- South Area Elementary School Capacity \$1,133,809.94
- North Elementary Capacity \$1,095,047.31
- Debt Service \$700,000

Authorize the Superintendent, or designee, to request Brevard County approve the allocation request and disburse the Educational Impact Fees available through March 31, 2021.

Approve utilizing \$700,000 in capital funds for the Mims Cafetorium project pending approval and disbursement of the recommended allocation of educational facilities impact fees by the Brevard County Commission.


