Request Authorization to Increase Amount of Purchase Order

SUBJECT:

Request the Board to authorize increasing Purchase Order 4500095615 made to Nextran Truck Center from \$91,000 to \$140,000.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The increase requested is an additional \$49,000 over the current purchase order of \$91,000.

DEPT/OFFICE:

Solid Waste Department

REQUESTED ACTION:

Request permission for the Board to authorize the Purchasing Office to increase purchase order 4500095615 with Nextran Truck Center to \$140,000.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION and BACKGROUND:

Nextran is the County's approved vendor, and the exclusive Mack Truck dealer. Brevard County's over-the-road tractors are all Mack Trucks, which have been the low bid for the existing fleet. These trucks have given good service, but they have seen hard use in recent years.

In prior years the purchase order has not exceeded \$100,000; and therefore, the department expected the current year to be the same. Unfortunately because of the two hurricanes in the last two years and the increase in garbage generated the tractors have begun to require above normal repairs. This year Solid Waste has had to replace all fifth wheels on the trailers, which is not a normal repair. As the fleet ages the repairs will continue to increase until the replacement of the fleet is completed.
