Requested Action:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners declare the week of April 10, 2016 – April 16, 2016 National Public Safety Telecommunications Week.

Summary Explanation & Background:

Congress has designated the second week of April each year as National Public Safety Telecommunications Week to further public awareness and recognition of those individuals who are the public's first point of contact with emergency services.

The Enhanced 9-1-1 Administration Office, utilizing sophisticated equipment provided by the local exchange carrier and with the cooperation of nine (9) municipalities, the Brevard County Sheriff's Office and the Brevard County Fire Rescue Department has provided quality access to 9-1-1 for citizens of Brevard County.

Our Public Safety Telecommunicators, are an integral part of the Brevard County E9-1-1 System. They are the first of our "first responders" in a crises situation. This Resolution recognizes all Public Safety Telecommunicators for their dedication to duty, professionalism and commitment to saving lives, property and the prevention of crime.


